HABITAT AND ECOLOGY

Lives in the vicinity of coral reefs. Feeds mainly on zooplankton and benthic algae.

DISTRIBUTION

Mediterranean record: a single specimen was photographed underwater from Israel in 2015 (Marcelli *et al.*, 2016).

Original distribution: wide Indo-Pacific but not in the Red Sea.

HABITAT AND ECOLOGY

Inhabits shallow waters in the vicinity of rocks and corals. Feeds on algae and seagrass. Eggs and larvae planktonic.

DISTRIBUTION

Mediterranean record: a single specimen was filmed in Sitges, Spain in 2008 (Weitzmann *et al.*, 2015).

Original distribution: Indo-West Pacific from South Africa to Samoa. Not occurring in the Red Sea.
